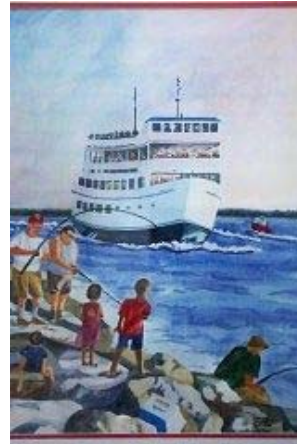


Geo-caching throughout West Greenwich
